
Our impact at a glance

Medical & Dental Outreach Clinics

Through collaboration with our partners, we have provided care to more than 45,000 patients, trained over 800 healthcare workers with more than 150 volunteers right around the world.

Training and Capacity Building in Yemen

Partnering with Humanitarian Grand Challenges Canada, Butterfly Network, the Global Ultrasound Institute (GUSI) and MedGlobal, Bridge to Health is working to enhance the capacities of local physicians to screen for pediatric pneumonia, trauma, and women's health and pregnancy support in Yemen, three areas where there is immediate need and limited local capacity. Through this program, Yemeni physicians will be provided with training and equipment necessary to add POCUS to their diagnostic toolkit. The training program was entirely virtual due to the COVID-19 pandemic, with live sessions with ultrasound experts and POCUS online content through the GUSI platform.



Peru's Amazon Medical Project

The Yanamono Clinic based in Northeastern Peru in the Amazon Region has treated over 75,000 patients since its inception in 1990, most of whom are local residents who would not have had access to healthcare within a reasonable distance. In 2021, Bridge to Health entered into a partnership with the Amazon Medical Project to expand the services of the clinic, while developing a sustainable structure that will continue to grow in the coming years. This year, our goal is to enhance the diagnostic and treatment capacities of the clinic's local staff and to deliver clinical outreaches to the surrounding regions.

BTH East-African Medical Education Fund

In celebration of our 10 years of out-reach in the East-African region and inspired by the continued support from our network of past volunteers and donors, in 2021 Bridge to Health was proud to announce a new Medical Education Fund specifically for applicants who received an acceptance letter to a participating university. Our first recipient of the grant, Erick Komunga, is a previous Bridge to Health volunteer. Erick was accepted into the University of Nairobi's medicine program.
